



## Spanish Teacher, Part-time

Madison Waldorf School is seeking a creative, engaged and motivated teacher to lead our Spanish program. Native speakers are preferred but very fluent non-native speakers are encouraged to apply.

This position would lead our classes 1-8 in a journey of language learning. The early grades focus is on movement, song, games to learn language through experience. Gradually building on the foundation in the early grades, the students are introduced to writing and reading while continuing to build speaking, comprehension and auditory skills. Our middle school program follows a more traditional model, with focus on building fluency in speaking, listening, writing and reading.

This position is for 15 hours per week.
